- 👉 **Diary is a personal, private document.**
- 👉 **Anne hoped to have this diary published after the war.**
- 👉 **Anne was very optimistic; others might find inspiration from her.**
- 👉 **People should know what happened in the Holocaust – not many people talked about it then.**
