3. The entries must be under two pages, maximum 1000 words
4. The Anne Frank Trust UK reserves the right to use the entries both online and offline but copyright will be credited to the writers. The Anne Frank Trust UK acknowledges that you will retain ownership of copyright in your entry and that any use of the entry by The Anne Frank Trust UK other than related to the competition will require your specific consent. For the avoidance of doubt, in entering this competition you agree that The Anne Frank Trust UK has the right to edit and reproduce your work electronically or in print as appropriate in conjunction with the competition. The Anne Frank Trust UK reserves the right to display, reproduce and publish in any media any entry, without payment.
5. Your entry must be accompanied by your name and contact details. The information you supply will only be used for the purposes of administering this competition, unless we are obliged or permitted by law to disclose it.
